

## Service Types

### RADIATOR SEAL REPLACEMENT SERVICE

Seal Replacement only - We will separate the appropriate sections of your radiator and replace faulty seals only; we will use either Klingersil or EPDM rubber seals.

The price for this will be determined by the time taken to do complete the job plus the costs of any parts. Our hourly rate is £60 plus vat or £325 plus vat per full day.

When we undertake the seal replacement service we do not refinish paintwork or attempt any cosmetic work what so ever. Bear in mind that we do often have to use lots of force. We therefore need hold radiator down with weights in order to stop them moving under these forces. It's a very dirty job, your radiators will get very dirty and (in all probability) scratched.

Of course we'll do our best to take care of them and clean them up as far as we can afterwards. Do bear in mind that even with our best efforts a small percentage of radiators will not come apart and may even break during the process – you will still need to pay for the work up to this point.

### CAST IRON RADIATOR REFURBISHMENT SERVICE

Refurbishment Service - We will pressure test your radiator, remove, reposition and replace the end bushes, clean internally, strip back to bare metal and repaint all sections.

For this service we do not need to dismantle your radiator and the finished product is no less attractive than the "Full restoration" service. However, it is dependent upon your radiator s being leak free with all the seals being in good order. If we find a leak we will inform you so that you can make a decision whether you want to proceed to the full renovation service. Again, you will need to pay for the work up to this point.

Prices for the refurbishment service start at £225 plus vat per radiator.

### FULL CAST IRON RADIATOR RENOVATION SERVICE

Full Renovation Service - We will separate the sections of your radiator, remove any broken sections if required (we may even be able to replace them with good used sections if we have them available for your radiator) and replace all seals. We will also remove, re-position and replace the end bushes, clean internally strip back to bare metal, repaint all sections and pressure test your radiator. We do not powder coat fully restored radiators. Prices for the full renovation service start at £350 plus vat per radiator.

The full renovation service could be very expensive because of the sheer amount of work required, It may be more cost effective to buy a replacement radiator from us and so this service is only for those who really love their radiator or who must have that precise radiator replaced precisely where it came from.

## MIXED SERVICE

Mixed Service. We will dismantle your radiator only up to the section where a fault has been found and either remove or replace the broken section. We will not continue dismantling your radiator past that point. Seals up to the broken section will be replaced but not beyond that point. The mixed service is typically undertaken when a radiator enters the workshop under a refurbishment service but a material fault is found. Price for the mixed service is based upon the full renovation service but is ultimately determined (and capped) by how many sections we actually need to dismantle. The remaining sections will be treated as a refurbishment service.

Please bear in mind that the above prices are for radiators only and do not include ancillaries.

Please ask your plumber to remove the valve stems from the radiator. Valve stems are not part of the radiator and are easily damaged and/or lost in transit. In cases where the valve stems cannot be removed by your plumber we are happy to remove them for you but this may damage them and is done entirely at the customer's risk. Whilst we will do our best, we cannot guarantee your valve stems for loss or damage.
